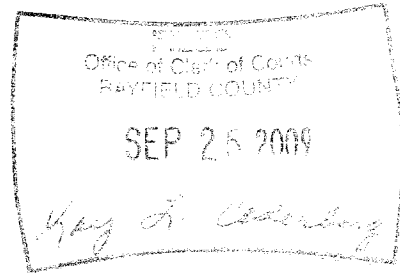


I hereby certify that by virtue of the within warrant I searched the named premises on the following date(s) and found the following things:

Inspection date: September 24, 2009 3:10 to 4:10 p.m.

Observations:

- Land disturbance has occurred over much of the site. The overall land disturbance is estimated at 22 acres (700 feet x 1400 feet).
- Surveyor's stakes along the length of a relatively flat, graded corridor labeled, "Runway CL Sta ##", appear to mark the centerline stations for a future runway.
- Along several sections of the corridor, soil indentations were evident that could be associated with a mechanical soil compactor.
- Over much of the site, a mix of oats, turnips and rape seed had been planted. The stage of growth suggests that planting occurred several weeks ago.
- At numerous locations over the length of the site, flags labeled "Wetland delineation" were noted. Such flags are used to identify the boundaries of wetland complexes.
- Within the areas demarcated as wetlands, extensive clearing of trees and shrubs has occurred. Wetland fill or excavations in these areas as a result of the clearing would be anticipated and require further assessment by a wetland expert.
- Windrows of trees stumps and other woody debris were present in several locations that were surrounded by wetland flags.
- Two meteorological stations had been erected at each end of the corridor. The stations appeared to be equipped to measure wind speed and direction.
